Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts must be submitted using the Word template provided, limited to one A4 page. Please adhere to the set margins and font size, and submit as a Word document (not PDF)
- State the abstract title, followed by authors' names and departmental affiliations
- Indicate the presenting author using an asterisk and whether s/he is a DPhil student, postdoc or fellow and whether clinical or non-clinical.
- Abstracts must include the research rationale (written for a non-specialist audience), methodology, results and conclusions
- Citations in the text should be numbered sequentially and kept to a minimum
- A figure should be included if appropriate
- We encourage the inclusion of a graphical abstract, which is a single-panel image designed to give non-specialised readers an immediate understanding of the poster's take-home message

We can display a maximum of 50 posters and request that from within large research groups a maximum of 2 abstracts are submitted.

<u>Abstracts</u> are selected for poster presentation on the basis of quality and overall balance across the BHF CRE themes. Poster authors will be informed of the selection outcome by Monday 5th November.

<u>Posters</u> are judged by the following criteria:

- Innovation and impact of the research presented
- Excellence of presentation of the work and results
- Clarity of discussion between the presenting author and the poster judges

There will be a prize for the best student posters (clinical and non-clinical categories) and the best non-student poster.
